Pricing & Logistics

Retreat Format

Retreat format and speaking engagements are flexible to meet the needs of the parish. The most popular format for a retreat is a Saturday morning gathering that runs for approximately three hours. Below is an example of a retreat:

8:30 – 9:00 Gathering
(coffee, rolls, fruit)

9:00 – 11:30 Body of Retreat
(2 sessions with a break)

1st Session reminds us how special we are to God.

2nd Session shows us how to lay our burdens down and includes the opportunity for one on one prayer.

11:30 – 12:00 Mass

Cost of the retreat:

We will take a free-will offering (done by a church member). If it is less than \$250, the church is asked to make up the difference.

Parish Responsibilities:

Hospitality - 2 or 3 women who will organize, provide, set up and serve the refreshments and welcome the women as they arrive.

Childcare - someone to organize childcare if needed.
